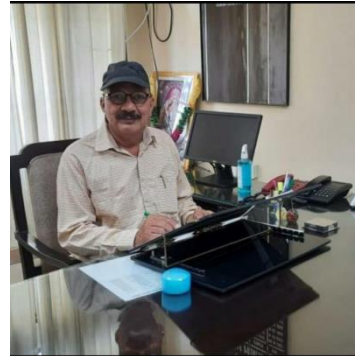

2. INTRODUCTION

Sarla Memorial Government Girls College, Safidon is Higher educational institute situated at the outskirts of the town Safidon District, Jind Haryana. The College has a humble start in July 2011 in an old building of Government Senior secondary School, Two programmes namely Bachelor of Arts (B,A,) and Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com,) were introduced in the year 2011. The college was shifted to the present site campus of 16.15 acres in Nov. 2017. Since then the college is continuously growing in terms of infrastructure and learning resources. Students from the town and surrounding villages come to study here. Initially this college was affiliated with Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, now w.e.f. session 2017-18 the college is Affiliated with Chaudhary Ranbir Singh University, Jind. The college has completed its NAAC Accreditation in the year 2021. The college has a student strength of 722 in the Academic Year 2022-23.

The College is equipped with 8 departments & 17 faculty members who are Qualified and Experienced. Many of the departments render free consultancy services for students and society. The college has a strong, dedicated and committed teaching faculty. The teaching faculty is engaged in research work such as paper presentation & publications.

A number of co-curricular and extra-curricular activities are regularly organized throughout the year. The college offers sports facilities to the students. It has a sports ground and other facilities for indoor games like carom, table tennis, chess etc. Students of the college represented the university in Inter-university championships. 4.11 SUBJECT SOCIETIES

4.11.1 YOUNG GEOGRAPHER'S CLUB

The Young Geographer's Club, a subject society of the Geography department and led by Convener Dr. Tejvir Saini, is a platform dedicated to the all-round development of geography students. This society focuses on enhancing the academic experience through co-curricular activities. Various events, including quizzes and declamation contests, are organized to provide students with opportunities to delve deeper into geographical knowledge and showcase their understanding of the subject. The Young Geographer's Club becomes a dynamic forum where students can engage, learn, and contribute to their academic and personal growth within the fascinating realm of geography.

1. THE YOUNG GEOGRAPHERS CLUB- was restructured at the starting of academic session 2022-23 in the month of August. The students were invited to become members of the club through notice.

Eligibility- Meritorious, talented and laborious Geography students can become members of this club.

Purpose- Through this club, our college will try to develop talented young geographers. This club will guide them and monitor their progress on a regular basis and will also organize different activities for their development .

System Created for Guidance and Monitoring of Progress of Club Members-

WhatsApp Group was created for this club to share information and reading material and also give them 'DIY' (Do It Yourself) tasks on a regular basis. Students were asked to create a separate Notebook for 'DIY' tasks given through this club. If needed, Students could ask for guidance for these 'DIY' in WhatsApp group or in person as per their convenience. For

monitoring of the given tasks, faculty members could ask about the progress of ‘DIY’ tasks and will check their notebook in person as per the convenience of both the faculty members and the club members.

No. of Members- In this regard there was an overwhelming response from the students. 40 Members registered themselves in this club.

Progress Report of the Members - Initially, the response was good. But, later quite many members didn’t take ‘DIY’ tasks seriously and didn’t complete them. They were less responsive in interactions with faculty members both online and in person. But, around 10 students were quite good and responsive about these given tasks and they also completed these tasks on time and they have maintained their notebook in a proper way.

2. GEOGRAPHY EXHIBITION AT COLLEGE LEVEL-

A Geography Exhibition was organized by the Young Geographers’ Club under the aegis of Deptt. of Geography on 5th December 2022. Students participated in this exhibition enthusiastically and a total of 11 participating teams were there and each consisting 2-3 students. 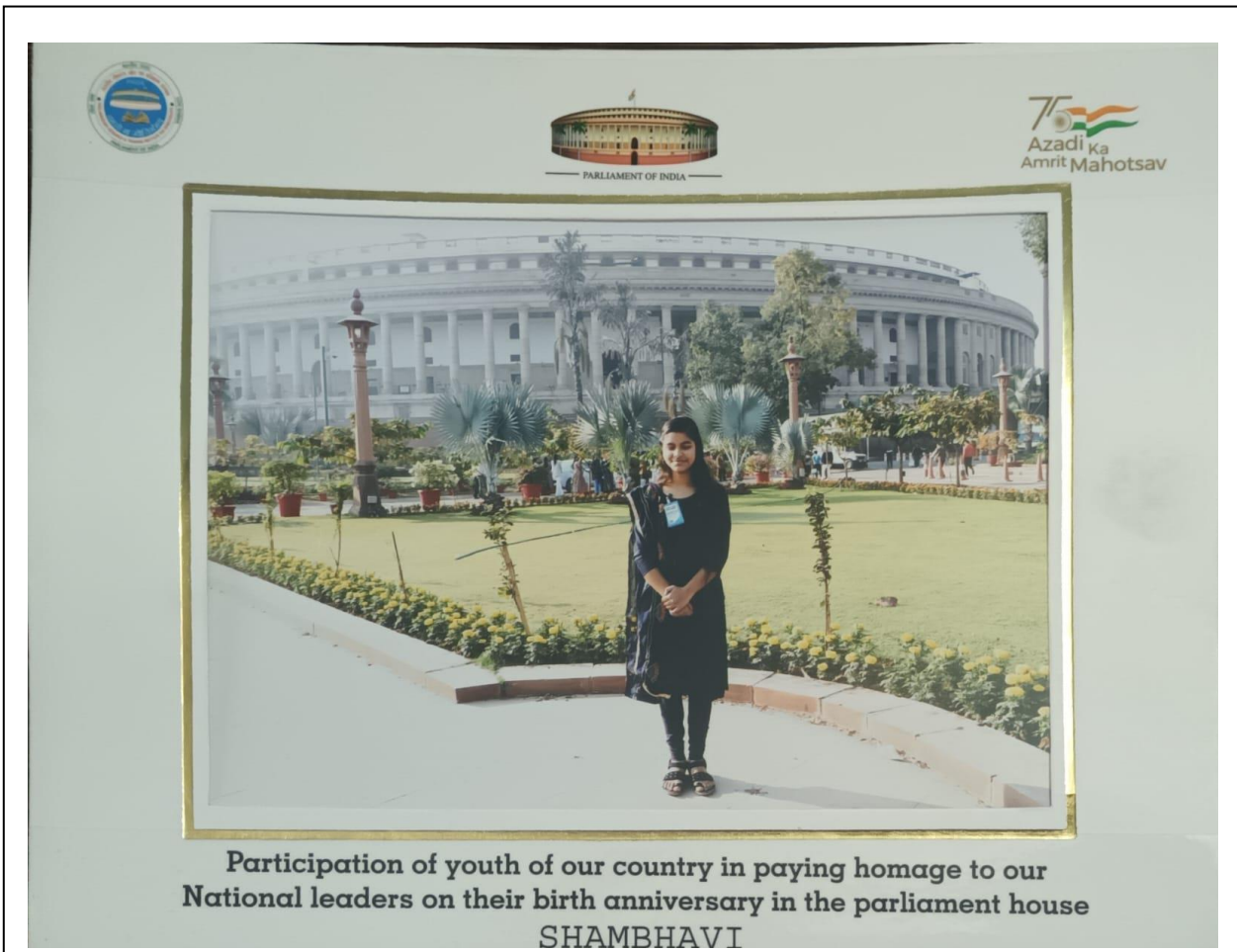
