

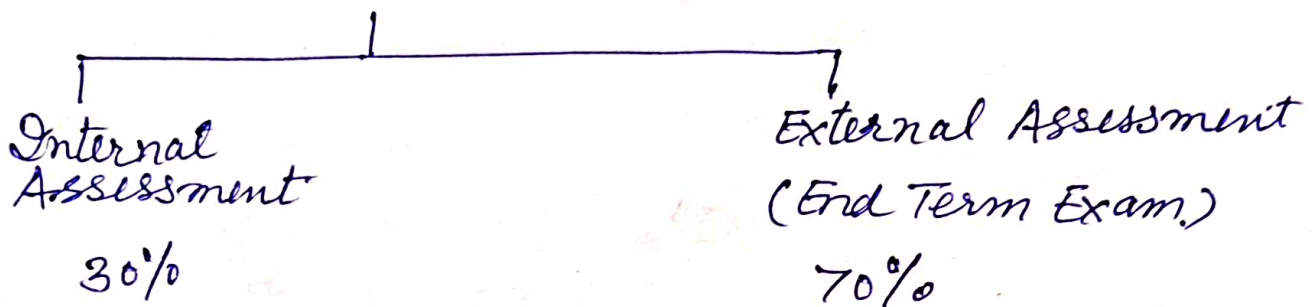

Division of Marks where Course Composition is Theory & Practical

<u>Theory + Practical</u>	<u>Theory (IA+ETE)</u>	<u>Practical (IA+ETE)</u>	Total
3 + 1 (Credits)	$20 + 50 = 70$	$10 + 20 = 30$	100
2 + 2 (Credits)	$15 + 35 = 50$	$15 + 35 = 50$	100
2 + 1 (Credits)	$15 + 35 = 50$	$5 + 20 = 25$	75
1 + 1 (Credits)	$10 + 20 = 30$	$5 + 15 = 20$	50
0 + 4 (Credits)	- - -	$30 + 70 = 100$	100

Marks required to Pass

⇒ 40% (Theory + IA.)
ETE

ET.E → End Term Exam

At least 40% in ETE

Example: 70 MARK (ETE.)

$$70 \times \frac{40}{100} = \boxed{28}$$

ETE - 50 Marks

$$50 \times 40\% = 20$$

ETE - 35 Marks

$$35 \times \frac{40}{100} = 14 \text{ Marks}$$

Pass mark (40%) is must in end term exams

Candidate is not required to pass in IA and ETE separately

If any student is fail in IA then she have to get more marks in ETE

Example

Total Marks 100

IA Marks - 5

Total Required Marks to get Pass - 40

She have to get $40 - 5 = 35$ mark in ETE to pass the exam.
